

EDUI 6005 – Final Project



18-20 points: Awesome

The student exceeds the goals of the project criteria and creates an image that utilizes all of the required tools and techniques listed below. The original images used were created or taken by the student and have good quality and resolution. The project makes excellent use of color and composition theory. The final image is interesting and creative.



16-17 points: Great

Student **meets all of project criteria** and project standards, but **not** to the level of complexity and sophistication achieved in “awesome” level. Project demonstrates good use of color and composition. The original images used were created or taken by the student. Student exhibits effort in the completion of the project.



14-15 points: Acceptable

Student meets **some** of the project criteria. Student needs to improve on the development of the concept. The project may lack some focus and cohesion. The image makes poor use of color and composition. Project demonstrates limited content. Student may need to improve in the implementation of the lesson or pay closer attention to detail. The images are not original or have poor quality. Project demonstrates average effort in the completion of the project.



0 - 13 points: Does not meet project criteria. Lacks understanding of the material. Project lacks cohesion and lacks consistency.

Project Grading Criteria

The presentation should meet the following criteria.

- The image dimensions are between 5”-10” (width) and 5”-10” (height) with a resolution of 300PPI
- Originality
- All images used must be original and from the student.
- Uses at Layer Blending on at least one layer such as, Overlay, Screen, Multiply, etc.
- Utilizes at least one Adjustment Layer such as Levels, Curves, Hue/Saturation
- At least one of the layers should utilize a Layer Style of your choice
- Used at least one Filter to create the image
- The final image demonstrate creativity

If you have a project idea that does not fall into the criteria shown above, you may do so with permission. For example, since your last class activity was centered on pixel art, you may use this as an opportunity to create an entire scene or characters as part of something bigger you want to pursue in the future. E-mail me or check-in with me during class. Remember, this project is for you. I encourage you to create something that you can use beyond the course.
